We are currently seeking applications from students to be considered for the 2025 Year 7 iXtend Class at each campus.

The iXtend High Potential Classes

At Denison College we have an ongoing commitment to meet the needs of all students. The High Potential and Gifted Education Classes at each campus cater for those students who show exceptional ability in the intellectual and creative domains, as well as those who have the self-motivation and capacity for high level individual and group project work.

The purpose of these classes is to challenge students in the core curriculum areas of English, Mathematics, Science, PDHPE, History and Geography, while developing their skills in the areas of critical thinking, research, collaboration and problem solving. We encourage students to challenge themselves and their learning through improving self- understanding, study habits and goal setting. The iXtend classes at each campus provides a quality, rigorous and intellectually stimulating learning environment.

Each class will contain between 25 and 30 students. It will operate on the regular school timetable and students will remain in this class group for the majority of their subjects. They will also participate in smaller classes with other students from Year 7 for practical subjects in the Creative Arts and TAS faculties.

Identification

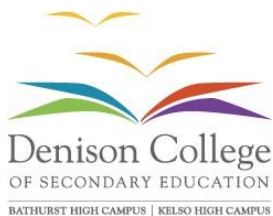
The identification of suitable students for this class will be managed by the College team in collaboration with the year group deputy principal. Students will be identified through a selection process that includes parent and student nominations, as well as primary school teacher nomination, examination of academic data to date and commitment to learning, and a writing sample collected during the student's Transition to High School visit. Parents may be contacted to provide relevant information regarding their child's application if it is not available on request from their primary school. Placement in the class will be reviewed at the conclusion of Semester 1 and Semester 2, 2025, with movement communicated to parents if required.

The following forms must be completed by the parent, student and their teacher and submitted to your Campus by the end of Term 2, the year prior to your student commencing High School.
