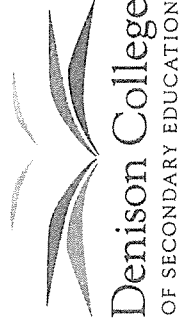

Monday 11th September – Friday 22nd September 2017 (Weeks 9-10 of Term 3)

All examinations will be held in the GYM and Theatre. The **Music Aural exam** will be held in Theatre .

There will be no Year 11 roll call.

All morning examinations begin at **9.10am**.

Afternoon examinations commence at **1.10pm**.

All examinations start with 5 minutes reading time, except for English Paper 1, which has 10 minutes reading time. Students should be ready to enter the rooms 5 minutes before the scheduled time the examination will commence. The duration of each examination in hours is shown in brackets after each examination.

TAFE runs as **normal** on Wednesday. You are required to attend your TAFE class during this week if you are enrolled in a TVET course

Dance, Drama and Music Practicals are arranged by your class teacher.

Students who do shared courses at Kelso High Campus will do their examinations **at Bathurst High Campus**, with the papers collected separately and sent to Kelso High Campus for marking.

Students only need to attend school at the times set down for the examinations. Please be aware the Library/Senior Study is available for study purposes.

If you are not able to attend an examination, you must contact the school and leave a message for **Ms Dunshea**. On your return to school you must see **Ms Dunshea** and arrange a time to do the examination. You will need to fill in an Illness or Misadventure form for your absence.

ADVICE FOR YOUR REVISION:

To maximise your study time, you should find out from your teacher of each course how the examination will be set out and organised. You should also find out what types of questions will be asked (eg. essays, reports, short answer) as this should help your revision. In your revision you should also think of possible questions that you may be asked and consider how you would answer these. This is good revision practice.



Examination Rules and Instructions to Candidates

1. Be in attendance at least 10 minutes before the start of an examination.
2. Wear school uniform.
3. Take only the equipment specified for the particular examination into the venue. You may bring black pens, highlighters, a pencil, eraser and sharpener. Do not bring paper or written material, liquid paper, correction tape or pencil case. You may bring water in a clear bottle to have on your desk. No eating.
4. Mobile phones, programmable watches and other electronic devices are to be switched off and placed in your bag. Your bag will be placed in a secure room.
5. Enter the examination venue only with the permission of the supervising Teacher-In-Charge.
6. Entry will not be permitted 30 minutes after the start of an examination. Latecomers will finish at the designated examination time. There is no extension of time.
7. You are expected to use your time wisely and use all the examination time. If you choose not to use your time wisely, you can leave after the first hour, but not in the last 15 minutes.
8. You begin the examination only when instructed to do so by the supervising teacher.
9. Toilet breaks will require you to be accompanied by a supervising teacher.
10. Speaking or making any other form of contact with a person other than a supervising teacher while in the exam room is not allowed and consequences will apply.
11. If you feel unwell or upset you must tell a supervising teacher. Ask for an Illness/Misadventure form.
